General Requirements for All CE Programs

- → Must have significant intellectual or practical content;
- → Primary objective must be to improve professional competence;
- → Topics of clinical benefit to consumers;
- → Instructors qualified by education or experience to provide instruction in the subject matter;
- → Presented in a setting suited to the educational activity of the program;
- → Content based upon scientific evidence generally accepted by the profession.

Once you conclude that a program meets the general requirements listed above, use this flow chart to make your final determination if a program is acceptable *Board Mandated* CE:



- *Interactive Means: → A program in which you are able to interact with and speak to the instructor OR
 - → If the program is offered online, you must be able to register and log in, and be tracked and timed in a database where attendance is monitored. The program must include a mechanism to evaluate your knowledge of the subject matter.
